

Whitburn Neighbourhood Plan

South Tyneside Council: Regulation 18 Decision Statement

South Tyneside Council's Cabinet has considered the Report of the Independent Examination into the Submission Draft Whitburn Neighbourhood Plan, published on 23 February 2022. As required under paragraph 12 of Schedule 4B to the Town and Country Planning Act 1990, the Council has considered each of the recommendations made by the Examiner and has made a decision on whether to accept or reject the recommendations.

The Independent Examiner concluded that it would be necessary to delete one of the policies, improve the mapping of policies and clarify the wording of policies and supporting text. The Council considers that the Plan, as modified, meets the basic conditions as set out in paragraph 8(2) of Schedule 4B to the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 and that the Plan complies with provisions made under sections 38A and 38B of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004.

Accordingly, the decision of the Council is that the Plan will proceed to referendum. The Council is satisfied that the referendum area shall be the designated Whitburn Neighbourhood Forum Area. **The date of the referendum is Thursday 4 August 2022.** Details such as who is able to vote and how to do so are available in the *Referendum Information Statement (including information for voters)* which can be accessed online via:
