## STEP 2

South Tyneside Council will make a decision about the support that you require, they will also advise you of your options. At this point you may be able to make a claim for Universal Credit.

- Once you make your new claim to Universal Credit you will be offered an initial interview date to attend your local job centre.
  - Your ID must be verified in a face-to-face meeting, ideally using 3 forms of ID e.g. passport, driving licence, birth certificate.
    - Other aspects of your declaration including housing costs and education must also be verified.
