We are deeply troubled by the chair's insinuation that members who opposed the outcome acted unlawfully. This is unacceptable and sets a dangerous precedent for how dissenting voices are treated within our governing bodies.

The highly politicised atmosphere within the planning committee is creating a toxic environment. It is vital that our councillors can perform their duties as community representatives and volunteers without facing threats or intimidation.

We call upon South Tyneside Council to take immediate and decisive action to address the statement made by the chair. It is crucial to restore public confidence in our democratic processes and ensure that all members are supported and protected. The Green Party remains committed to fostering a transparent and fair decision-making environment for the betterment of our community.
